Pass it Around: Visual Culture and the Internet

This Seminar will explore the increasingly important relationship between visual culture and the Internet.with an emphasis on understanding the profound effect the shift from analog to digital technology has had on how we make, look at, talk about and distribute images in contemporary culture.

Focusing on the myriad ways in which individuals and social organizations engage with the vast archive of digital content circulating on the Internet, the class will touch on a variety of interrelated issues, including:

- Social media and the creative practice of re-mixing, re-contextualizing and re-distributing fragments of digital culture, and the related issues of authorship and copyright.
- The increasingly important place of post-production, collaborative practice and curatorial strategies in visual culture.
- How new imaging technologies and information systems are disrupting and re-defining the identity of artists, their work and their relationship to cultural institutions.

Class time will be split between lectures and in-class discussions Students will be encouraged to apply material discussed in class to their own visual and conceptual interests.

In addition to reading a couple of texts, we will look at and discuss a wide sampling of historical and contemporary visual material.
